Subject: June 27 Bluegrass Jam

Hi Tony and Nema,

We know you will be happy to hear that Kleb Woods has resumed activities at a limited capacity, and we can hold the June 27 Bluegrass Jam with a few restrictions. You will have to hold the jam in the auditorium or on the porch, with seats spaced 6 feet apart (except for members of the same household). We are able to fit 15 socially distanced chairs in a circle in the auditorium. There may be additional room for a few listeners in the auditorium depending on the number of pickers/size of the circle, with a maximum of 20 people in the auditorium at one time. We can also set up chairs outside of the auditorium for listeners.

You may want to request that pickers let you know if they plan to attend the jam, so that you have an idea of how many people to expect and can plan accordingly. If you get more than 15, you can always divide into two groups and have one group play on the porch and the other group play in the auditorium.

We are currently asking activity participants to please wear a mask when inside buildings, and to maintain social distancing at all times. We have masks available for those who need one.

Lastly, serving refreshments is not currently allowed, so you may want to recommend that the pickers each bring their own drinks and snacks.

Please let me know if you have any questions. Otherwise, we look forward to having you back at Kleb on June 27!
